Call for Papers

The 128th meeting of the Tennessee Academy of Science will be held at Austin Peay State University in Clarksville, Tennessee on **Saturday**, November 17, 2018. Registration will be in the Sundquist Science Complex. The business meeting, poster session, plenary session, lunch, and afternoon technical sessions will take place in designated buildings on campus; check the website prior to arriving or the meeting program at registration for location details. APSU is located at 601 College Street, Clarksville, TN, 37044, and the Sundquist Building is located on the corner of College and 8th Streets. Parking will be available in Lot 8, located nearby on 8th Street.

The plenary session for this year's meeting will feature Dr. Dwayne Estes, Professor of Biology at Austin Peay State University. Dr. Estes received his BS in Plant Biology from MTSU in 2003 and his PhD in Ecology and Evolutionary Biology from UT Knoxville, 2008. Dr. Estes's talk will be on The Southeastern Grasslands Initiative: "Charting a New Course for Conservation in the 21st Century."
