Tennessee Academy of Science 2019 Annual Meeting Announcement Call for Papers

The 129th meeting of the Tennessee Academy of Science will be held at Columbia State Community College in Columbia, Tennessee on **Friday, November 22, 2019**. Registration will be in the Waymon L. Hickman Building. The business meeting, poster session, plenary session, lunch, and afternoon technical sessions will take place in designated buildings on campus; check the website prior to arriving or the meeting program at registration for details. CSCC is located at 1665 Hampshire Pike, Columbia, TN 38401. The Hickman Building is at the corner of Hampshire Pike and Rutherford Lane. **NOTE: CSCC has five locations. Be sure to enter the Columbia location on Hampshire Pike into your GPS.**

The plenary session for this year's meeting will feature Dr. Larisa DeSantis, Assistant Professor of Earth and Environmental Sciences at Vanderbilt University. Dr. DeSantis received her BS at the University of California, Berkeley in 2000, her MEM from Yale University in 2003, and her PhD from the University of Florida in 2009. Dr. DeSantis will talk about her interdisciplinary research using modern, historic, and fossil records to examine floral and faunal responses to climate change, with a focus on mammalian communities and their environments during the Cenozoic.

We are piloting an electronic submission process this year so presenters have the option of submitting abstracts at the link available on the website OR emailing abstracts to the appropriate section chair (the section chair list is attached and on the website).
