2022 Annual Meeting Announcement
Call for Papers

The 132nd meeting of the Tennessee Academy of Science will be hosted at Tennessee State University in Nashville, Tennessee on **Friday, November 18, 2022**. Registration will be in Humphries Hall. Tennessee State University is located at 3500 John A. Merritt Boulevard, Nashville, TN 37209, and Humphries Hall is located at 3104 John A. Merritt Boulevard. Street parking is available, directly across the street from Humphries Hall (31st Ave N) and at the visitors parking lot on the corner of John A. Merritt Boulevard and 33rd Avenue North. Please check the website prior to arriving or the meeting program at registration for additional location details.

The plenary session for this year's meeting will feature Dr. Jennifer Cartwright from the United States Geological Survey. Dr. Cartwright received her Ph.D. in biology from Tennessee State University and studies climate-change impacts on a variety of terrestrial, wetland, and freshwater ecosystems across North America. Her talk is titled "Climate Change Impacts Across Tennessee".

Tennessee Academy of Science members and individuals, including students sponsored by TAS members, are invited to present at the Annual Meeting. Titles and abstracts should be submitted electronically by **October 17, 2022 at midnight central time**.
